

## **WHY WE NEED A WATER EXTRACTION MORATORIUM IN WELLS, ME**

**On August 19<sup>th</sup>, the Wells Selectmen voted to place the question of a water extraction moratorium on the November ballot in Wells. We are asking Wells citizens to support this moratorium because:**

- **There is presently no protection in our town if a large corporation wants to buy property in order to extract large amounts of water out of our aquifer for commercial use.**
- **The Kennebunk, Kennebunkport, Wells Water District came very close to signing a 30-year contract that would have allowed such commercial extraction of water.**
- **Much of the KKWWD Branch Brook Aquifer lies within the town of Wells.**
- **This moratorium would protect our town for 180 days while officials look at adopting a more permanent water extraction ordinance.**
